## How it Works

The Lake Superior Sea Kayak Pageant came from the question “why don’t we combine all of our wilderness trips to cover the entire North Shore?” In the spirit of Naturally Superior Adventures’ wilderness trips, this adventure doesn’t bite off more than it can chew. We’ve allotted plenty of time to cover the distance, explore the Lake Superior coastline and enjoy the camaraderie of fellow paddlers. There’s no pressure to paddle the entire route or “go the distance”—the coastline will be waiting for you when we organize the same trip next year. We created this trip with the expectation that a few paddlers



may sign up to paddle the entire route while the vast majority will choose one-, two- or three-week-long segments. As such, we expect a new group to be joining each segment of the journey, and hope to foster a sense of camaraderie among participants: Whether you paddle one section or them all, this truly is a unique experience.

Logistically, The Lake Superior Sea Kayak Pageant is surprisingly simple. Like our wilderness trips, each segment will begin with two hours of on the water sea kayak strokes and safety instruction, a great dinner and overnight in a bed and breakfast or Rock Island Lodge on Lake Superior. We will be rotating guides in and out of the trip; no one guide will paddle the entire trip, rather we will mix and match to add a diversity of experience, leadership styles, wilderness cuisine and interpretive skills. Week-long segments will be self-sufficient, with a re-supply of provisions and camping gear after each leg.

Do not be intimidated by the thought of stepping on the toes of “thru paddlers” taking on the entire trip. There’s nothing competitive about the Lake Superior Sea Kayak Pageant. It’s designed to be all about celebrating a world class paddling destination in high style and in the company of like-minded (soon to be) friends. Sign up for the vacation of your dreams and we promise to exceed your expectations.

## Equipment and Services – Partially Outfitted Trip

We Provide: Professional instruction and guiding; BBQ dinner and accommodations on Saturday evening and all meals to the following Saturday afternoon; fishing tug and vehicle shuttles; all group safety, camping, cooking, eating and sanitation gear.

You Provide: Fully outfitted expedition sea kayak (minimum 16.5 feet in length with two sealed bulkheads – rudder or skeg are recommended), tent, sleeping bag and pad and all personal equipment and clothing. A detailed recommended list is provided on registration.

Outfitting: We have expedition-outfitted sea kayaks (\$20 day) and tents (\$5 day) available at reduced rates for trip guests who prefer to use our equipment.
